“Look! The white gem appears,” they shout.

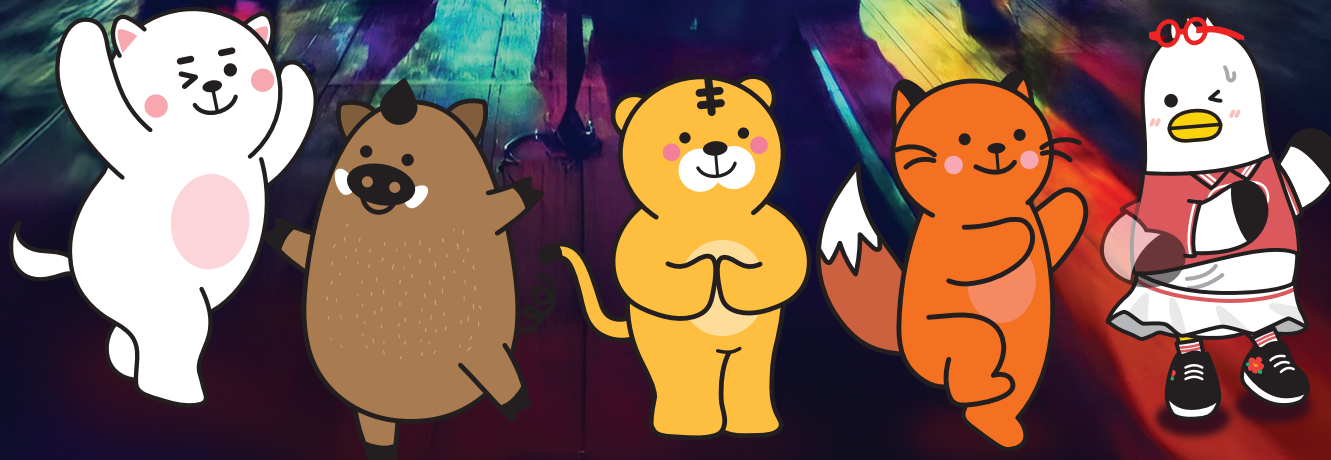
